I am grateful to the Literaturhaus Niederösterreich for the few weeks I spent in Krems, for the opportunity to collect my thoughts a little, walk, look at the Danube and visit the local museums. It was a difficult decision for me to leave Ukraine at this time, but I tried to use my time in Krems to the maximum advantage for my peace of mind and literary tasks.

During this time, I wrote several poems and an essay "Dead flowers of oblivion" (about the feeling of home - while I was in Krems, I learned that my house in Donetsk was shelled), the text will be published a little later in Ukrainian and in English translation. I worked with my English and Polish translators on books that are being prepared for publication in 2023. I also worked on my collection of poems (working title - "The wrong side of the apple").
