

Ulrike Ulrich

was born in Germany, lives and works as an author in Zurich.

In 2010 her debut *fern bleiben* was published at the Luftschacht Verlag (Vienna). Her second novel *Hinter den Augen* was published in 2013, followed by *Draussen um diese Zeit* in 2015. Ulrike Ulrich is part of the Zurich literature group index ([www.wortundwirkung.ch](http://www.wortundwirkung.ch)) and is involved in the art project *Literatur für das was passiert*.

Together with Svenja Herrmann Ulrike Ulrich published an anthology with literary texts dealing with the 60th anniversary of the human rights.

Her texts received numerous awards – as f.i. the Walter Serner-Prize 2010, the Lilly-Ronchetti-Prize 2011 and the Recognition Award of Zurich (in 2010 and 2013). Furthermore, in 2016 Ulrike Ulrich received a scholarship in London (awarded by the foundation Landis&Gyr) and was granted a working year from the city of Zurich for her new novel.

Besides her own writings during her residency in Krems Ulrike Ulrich will develop a Schulhausroman (a novel written by students) together with a school class in St. Pölten. The outcome of this project will be presented on March 30th, 14.00h, at the Museum Niederösterreich/ Museum of Lower Austria in St. Pölten.
